

OUR RENTAL SPACES

Richard & Rhoda Goldman Theater

Our beautifully finished theater features natural bamboo walls, raised theatrical seating for 178, and carpet made from 100% non-toxic recycled post-consumer material. The Goldman Theater is ideal for film screenings, lectures, appearances, panel discussions, and ceremonies. Features include a motorized retractable screen and custom sound reinforcement by Meyer Sound.



Tamalpais Room

Easily our most versatile space, the Tamalpais is ideal for a variety of special events, meetings, seminars, and presentations. Whether for a seated banquet, standing reception, or classic boardroom arrangement, this room can also be rented with the adjacent terrace for social and professional affairs. The Tamalpais features full audio/visual capabilities.



Hazel Wolf Gallery & Atrium Lobby

Featuring environmentally-focused artwork from regional and national artists, the Hazel Wolf Gallery & Atrium Lobby is the perfect space for your next reception. This flexible space can be set up for happy hours and galas, or meal seating for larger conferences.



Kinzie Room

The Kinzie opens directly into our Hazel Wolf Gallery & Atrium Lobby. This room is best suited for classes, meetings, or as a breakout room and features tackboard and whiteboard walls, an airwall to divide the room, and full audio/visual capabilities. The Kinzie is also our overflow space for the Goldman Theater.



Terrace

Our only outdoor space, the Terrace can be rented on its own or in conjunction with other rooms. With views of the Berkeley hills and featuring stunning landscape design, the Terrace is a great space for a cocktail mixer, meal seating, or informal gatherings. Please note that the Terrace is only available between 8 am and 10 pm due to Berkeley's noise curfew.

RENTAL RATES & POLICIES

Our rental rates include set-up and use of a wide variety of equipment, subject to availability.

Half Day rates include up to 8 hours of occupancy between 7 am and 3 pm, or 4 pm and midnight. Full Day rates include up to 12 hours of occupancy between 7 am and midnight. Discounts are available for multiple space bookings.

Rental of the Kinzie Room is required for catered events held on the first floor. This fee is only waived if Kinzie is already booked by another client.

We require a minimum of 15 business days notice for all booking inquiries. For rush bookings, payment and all required contracts and approvals are due no later than 10 business days before a confirmed event. Failure to do so will result in a cancellation of the booking.

Food, Beverage, and Alcohol Policies

All events featuring food and/or beverage are subject to a \$300 fee that is waived by booking a DBC Catering Partner. In addition, all packaging and servicewear must be reusable, recyclable or compostable, i.e., no single-use plastics. A Food & Beverage Policy packet is available by request.

All service of alcoholic beverages must be approved prior to an event. Alcohol liability insurance is required, and evidence of insurance must be provided by the client or their vendor a minimum of two weeks in advance. An ABC permit may also be required for events open to the public. Failure to secure and provide evidence of necessary permits and/or insurance by the required deadline will result in termination of the client's ability to serve alcohol.

Audio/Visual Services

Tamalpais Room, Kinzie Room, and Hazel Wolf Gallery Standard A/V Package: \$295 includes podium, one wireless microphone, projection screen, video and audio connection for a computer, and up to three hours of audio/visual technician assistance at start of occupancy. Additional audio/visual assistance is available and may be contracted for \$45/hour. *Please note that an audio/visual technician is required for the duration of events in the Hazel Wolf Gallery.*

Goldman Theater Standard A/V Package (required): \$325 includes podium, up to four wireless microphones, projection screen, video and audio connection for a computer, and technician assistance at start of occupancy, plus a technician fee of \$45/hour after the first three hours. *Please note that an audio/visual technician is required for the duration of the event.*

Goldman Theater Recording Package: \$575, inclusive of the above, as well as an HD recording

Internet

Complimentary WiFi is included with all rentals.

Security

Some evening and weekend events require a minimum of one security guard during the rental period. Additional security guards may be required depending on the scope of the rental. The rate for security personnel is \$55/hour per guard with a five-hour minimum.

Additional Fees

Extended Occupancy: Prior arrangements must be made and approved for all events in excess of the Half Day or Full Day window. A fee of \$195/hour per floor will be assessed for additional time. The deadline for occupancy changes is 72 hours prior to the first scheduled date of the event and is subject to availability.

Overage Penalty: We will assess a fee of \$200/hour plus 2x the hourly cost of staffing for any non-approved occupancy, such as early arrival or late departure.

Insurance

All meetings and events must be covered by client-provided liability insurance. Please inquire for limits and further details.

Transit and Parking

The Brower Center is just one block east of the Downtown Berkeley BART station.

Garage parking is available on an hourly basis at numerous nearby locations. The closest garage is the City of Berkeley's Oxford Garage, located directly underneath the Brower Center - enter at 2161 Kittredge Street.

Street parking is available on all streets surrounding the Brower Center. Parking is metered from 9 am - 6 pm Monday through Saturday.

Cancellation Policy

A booking deposit of 50% of the full rental fee is due when a contract is signed. The remaining 50% is due one month prior to the event. In the case of cancellation:

- More than 90 days before the first scheduled date: 100% of the booking deposit is refunded
- 30 to 90 days before the first scheduled date: 100% of the booking deposit is retained
- Less than 30 days before the first scheduled date: 100% of the full rental fee is retained
